Onsite Sewage System Professionals Licensure Regulations Summary (DPOR, 2022)

NOTE: Effective 3/1/22, the Board for Contractors amended its regulations to split the Sewage Disposal System (SDS) specialty into two new specialties: Alternative Sewage Disposal System (ADS) and Conventional Sewage Disposal System (CDS). 1- Conventional Sewage Disposal System (CDS) contracting- Can provide service for the installation, repair, improvement or removal of a treatment works consisting of one or more septic tanks with gravity, pumped, or siphoned convenyance to a gravity distributed subsurface drainfield. CDS licensure is necessary for performing jobs in excess of \$1,000.

2- Alternative Sewage Disposal System (ADS) contracting- Can provide service for the installation, repair, improvement or removal of a treatment works that is not a conventional onsite sewage system an does not result in a point source discharge. No other classification or specialty service provides this function. ADS licensure is necessary for performing jobs in excess of \$1,000.

3- Installers may perform maintenance work limited to in-kind replacement of light bulbs, fuses, filters, pumps, sewer lines, conveyance lines, distribution boxes, and header lines unless prohibited by local ordinance.
