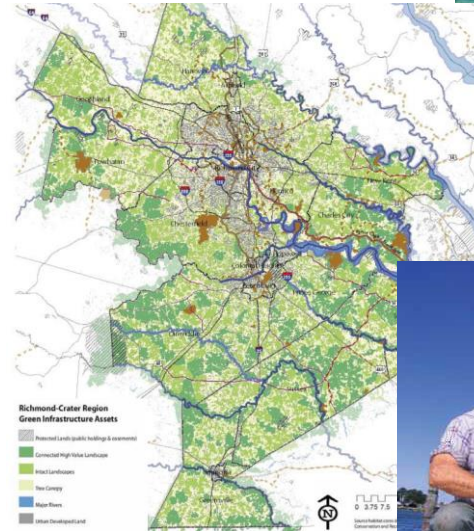

Oyster Heritage Program: 1999 – 2001 = \$1,490,000

- Construction of more than 80 sanctuary reefs
- Construction of over 1000 acres of harvest area
- Creation of Oyster Management Plan for the Lower Rappahannock River – Harvesting on a 3-year rotational schedule and a buy-back program for large oysters that were returned to sanctuaries

Restore and protect the aquatic resources of the barrier islands, bays and salt marshes along Virginia’s Eastern Shore

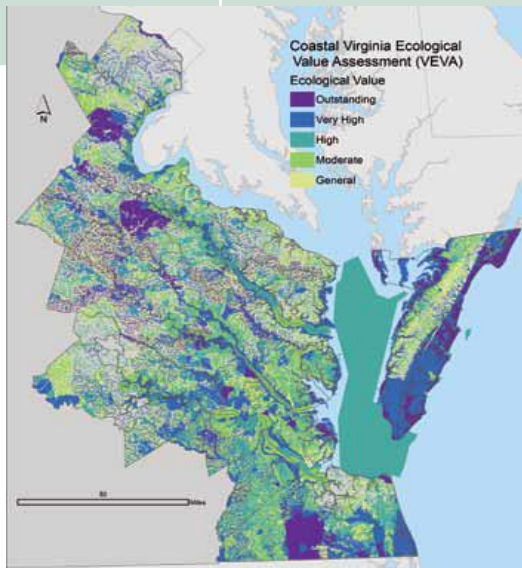

Product #1 - Restoration Site Selection
 Following six meetings in 2020 and 2021, some of which were held in concert with NOAA's Chesapeake Bay Office Leads of the York River and Small Coastal Basin Roundtable's *Seashore Habitat Steering Committee*, the project's target audience, the project team (Gonzalez, Ray, Leberg, Hardaway) determined that identifying discrete sites suitable for restoration was neither the most effective, nor enduring, approach toward site selection in the project geography for the target audience. An alternative, centralized approach consisting of a resource inventory, was thought to achieve similar objectives as the approach initially proposed. Specifically, a resource inventory would allow for greater flexibility and increased potential to embed sustainability within any future site selection process. The resulting *Inventory of Resources* was developed with input from the York River and Small Coastal Basin Roundtable *Nearshore Habitat Restoration Steering Committee* and vetting from the participants of the Middle Peninsula Restoration Workshop (Product #2).
