Welcome

Why Have A New Certification Program?

- Virginia Water Protection (VWP) Permit program regulates all state surface waters
- Federal jurisdiction has <u>changed</u>
- United States Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) has re-prioritized boundary confirmations due to workload
- Professional Wetland Delineator (PWD) only for identifying wetlands, not other surface waters




VSWD Program Objectives

- VSWD Certification Program is voluntary
- DEQ still accepts Corps verifications
- Baseline skills to correctly determine six parameters for state surface waters
 - Wetlands: wetland hydrology, hydric soils, and hydrophytic vegetation
 - Streams, ponds, open water: stream bank presence, stream bed presence, and ordinary high-water mark (OHWM)
- Accurate and reliable state surface waters delineations (SSWD)
 - Reduce incomplete VWP permit applications
 - Consistent submittal requirements
 - VWP permit review timeframes stay on track



Obtaining VSWD Certification: Overview





Step 1 – Obtain your PWD Certification

To obtain DEQ's Virginia State Waters Delineator Certification you must already hold a PWD license <u>from DPOR</u>.

Step 2 – Record your PWD # in CATS



DEQ uses the <u>Certification Accreditation Tracking</u>
<u>System (CATS)</u> for individuals to manage their DEQ
certifications.



Step 3 – Attend DEQ Stream ID Training

- Register in DEQ's <u>Environmental Learning</u> <u>Management System (ELMS)</u>
- Enroll in Wetlands: Stream Identification Curriculum
 - Upcoming Stream ID courses (includes field visit)
 - Northern: Sept. 6 DEQ Woodbridge Regional Office
 - Tidewater: Sept. 13 James City County Law Enforcement Center
 - Richmond: Sept. 27 DEQ Piedmont Regional Office
 - Stream ID exam
 - Unlocked after course roster completed

Step 4 – Complete DEQ Stream ID Exam

- Login to ELMS
- Access the <u>Wetlands: Stream</u> <u>Identification Curriculum</u>
- Launch the Stream Identification exam
 - o Timed: 45 minutes
 - Complete in one sitting
 - o 80% pass requirement
 - o 3 attempts





Step 5 – Email your curriculum completion certificate

- Once you complete your exam, View Completed Transcript in ELMS
- Download your curriculum certificate of completion and email it to: <u>certification@deq.virginia.gov</u>
- VSWD certification will be added to CATS.
- VSWD certification is valid for 3 years (CATS will remind you)
- Continuing education model for recertification


 <u>CATS (Certification</u> <u>Accreditation Tracking System)</u>

 ELMS (Environmental Learning Management System)





- Perform desktop research and fieldwork using the required VSWD information and forms
- Submit complete delineation information, including SSWD request form (with a signed Property Access Agreement)
- DEQ will perform completeness review within 15 days
- If complete information submitted, DEQ will verify delineation within 30 days (unless a site visit is necessary)
- SSWDs will be tracked in PEEP
- All site visits will be scheduled with VSWD who performed the work
- Once verified, the SSWD will suffice for VWP permitting purposes



VSWD Program Audit

- DEQ will track overall quality and completeness of submittals
- DEQ may field verify any delineation submitted for SSWD
- A trend of deficient work may result in more field visits
- A trend of deficiency is three or more of any combination of the following:
 - Incomplete Final Delineation Report submittals over a given calendar year; or
 - Significant concerns for accuracy over a given calendar year; or
 - Field verification changes over 5% of the submitted delineation boundary.
 - "Over 5%" is the percentage of:
 - (i) the total number of survey flags along the state surface waters boundaries, or
 - (ii) the cumulative length of boundary line, whichever is more.



I'm Not VSWD Certified?

- Submit delineation information, including SSWD request form (with a signed Property Access Agreement)
- DEQ will perform completeness review; striving for 15-30 days
- If complete information submitted, DEQ striving to verify delineation within 60 days (unless a site visit is necessary)
- Once verified, the SSWD will suffice for VWP permitting purposes
