investment recommendations, and initiating and directing other comprehensive measures to assure long-term compliance with environmental laws and regulations; the manager can ensure that the necessary systems are established or actions taken to gather complete and accurate information for permit application requirements; and where authority to sign documents has been assigned or delegated to the manager in accordance with corporate procedure;

- B. For a partnership or sole proprietorship: by a general partner or the proprietor, respectively; or
- C. For a municipality, state, federal, or other public agency: by either a principal executive officer or ranking elected official. For purposes of this part, a principal executive officer of a public agency includes:
 - 1. the chief executive officer of the agency, or
 - 2. a senior executive officer having responsibility for the overall operations of a principal geographic unit of the agency.
