- ❖ Some work in waters (e.g. rivers, streams, wetlands) may require a Department of the Army permit, pursuant to the Section 404 of the Clean Water Act and/or Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899.
- Some work in waters in response to a natural disaster may qualify for <u>Nationwide Permit 3 –</u> Maintenance.
- ❖ Some work in waters may also be exempt from the permitting requirements of Section 404 of the Clean Water Act, <u>33 CFR 323.4(a)(2)</u>. [Note: these exemptions do not apply to work conducted in waters subject to the Rivers and Harbors Act requirements.]
